WVMHA had another successful year, hosting teams from Recreation C to AA at age levels U11-15, and a very successful return of U18 at the A level

Tryouts were executed successfully and players appropriately placed on teams that developed and challenged their skills and abilities

The season ran smoothly with no major upsets. Number of games played, lack of travel, being confined to the southern end of the province was neither productive and negatively impacted the players experience This needs to be addressed with SMHL/HNS

Tryouts are projected to start mid sept for AAA and a week later for B-AA.

This year 2024/25 WVMHA has been awarded the host of the U13AAA regional team, and it will remain for the next 3 consecutive seasons
